

NOAA SARSAT Office Changes Address for Beacon Registrations

Suitland, Md., Dec. 20 – The NOAA SARSAT office changed addresses for 406 MHz beacon registrations last year. This change happened in September of 2012 so the agency could comply with new security procedures for mail processing. This change effects all 406 MHz emergency beacons including emergency position indicating radio beacons (EPIRBs), personal locator beacons (PLBs), emergency locator transmitters (ELTs), and ship security alert systems (SSAS). If you are about to renew your registration, or if you recently bought a beacon and have a pre-addressed registration envelope please check to ensure the address is correct before mailing. Forwarding of mail from the previous address will stop prior to September 1, 2014.
