





## National SAR Responsibilities | BILITIES




- Legal Agreement between SAR Coordinator and each State Governor
- Operational document between AFRCC/CC & each State SAR agency (Dictates day-to-day CONUS SAR Operations)

### **AFRCC Charter**


#### ☐ Area of Responsibility

- •Coordinate federal inland commercial, military, and interstate aeronautical SAR in the contiguous U.S.
  - Manage all inland beacon searches
  - Assist states with non-aircraft missions
  - Assist in locating missing/overdue aircraft
- States retain responsibility for Non-Aircraft SAR within their sovereign boundaries until they become overwhelmed or require specialized equipment
  - Requests for federal resources are made by the "Responsible Agency" within the state.
- Uvalidate requests / broker for federal assistance
  - Save life, limb, eyesight, or prevent undue suffering
  - "Ask, don't task"

#### Posse Comitatus

#### ☐Title 10 vs Title 14

- 18 U.S.C. 1385 Use of Army and Air Force as posse comitatus
  - Whoever, except in cases and under circumstances expressly authorized by the Constitution or Act of Congress, willfully uses any part of the Army or the Air Force as a posse comitatus or otherwise to execute the laws shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than two years, or both.


☐JAG on call for questionable situations

☐ Examples: Child abductions, fugitives


#### **AFRCC Resources**

- -faa



The AFRCC is authorized to request cell phone forensics IAW 18 U.S.C. § 2702 (b) (8)

- •§ 2702. Voluntary disclosure of customer communications or records
- •(b) Exceptions for disclosure of communications.-- A provider described in subsection (a) may divulge the contents of a communication--
- •(8) To a Federal, State, or local governmental entity, if the provider, in good faith, believes that an emergency involving danger of death or physical injury to any person requires disclosure without delay of communications relating to the emergency.

#### STATE CAP RESOURCES

- -fixed wing aircraft
- -ground search teams for non-aircraft missions
- -ground search teams for beacons
- -aircraft crash site supervision






### recap
